29.0 AUTOMATIC AID

- 29.1 Automatic Aid is the pre-determined response of a resource(s) as part of a dispatch to a neighboring jurisdiction.
- When resources are requested from a non-REDCOM agency to respond to a REDCOM incident, REDCOM shall advise the other agency's dispatch center of the assigned Control Channel and Tactical Channel.
- 29.3 REDCOM resources responding for automatic aid to a non-REDCOM agency shall be advised of the frequency assigned by the requesting dispatch center.
- Once released, resources shall advise the incident dispatch center of their release and will then switch back to their normal dispatch frequency.

 REDCOM resources that are released from a non-REDCOM incident must advise the REDCOM dispatcher of their AVAILABLE status on the REDCOM Channel or clear the unit on their MDC.
