31.0 HAZARDOUS MATERIALS INCIDENTS

- 31.1 When made aware of any hazardous materials incident within Sonoma County, REDCOM has the responsibility for the notification and dispatching of appropriate and necessary resources.
- 31.2 When the REDCOM Dispatcher receives a report of a hazardous materials incident in Sonoma County, the dispatcher shall:
 - 31.2.1 Advise the jurisdictional law enforcement agency. The determination whether law enforcement will respond shall be the decision of jurisdictional law enforcement agency.
 - 31.2.2 Dispatch or notify additional resources/agencies requested by the Incident Commander or as deemed necessary (e.g. Coast Guard, OES, Hospitals, etc.)
 - 31.2.3 Upgrade to the event type of HAZFULL upon request of IC or other responding resources in accordance with SOP 18.
