## 32.0 BURNING PERMITS

- 32.1 Residents of Sonoma County are allowed to conduct controlled burns of specified materials (normally brush and prunings related to an agricultural operation) if specific guidelines are followed.
- 32.2 Citizens who wish to conduct a controlled burn are responsible for contacting the appropriate local Fire Agency to obtain a permit, contacting the appropriate Air Quality Agency and notifying REDCOM prior to conducting a controlled burn.
- 32.3 Questions regarding controlled burning shall be referred to the jurisdictional fire agency.
- 32.4 The holders of the burn permits are asked to notify REDCOM burn line (565-1700) prior to conducting a controlled burn. The dispatch center shall record this information and use it appropriately to avoid dispatching resources to a legal controlled burn.
