33.0 LOCATION OF INTEREST (LOI)

33.1 An LOI file is maintained in CAD that is intended to provide essential and/or critical information regarding a specific location, occupancy or area to be available for responding field personnel.

33.1.1 Information in the LOI may include special hazards, fire department connection locations, alarm system panel locations, Knox Box locations, special patient information, etc.

33.1.2 Usually the LOI will be applied to a specific address, however, area LOI's may also be shown in CAD. An example could be a fumigation in progress that might impact a block range of a street, not just one address.

33.2 Jurisdictional agencies are responsible for maintaining accurate information in the LOI.

33.3 LOI information may have a purge date included. It is appropriate to include a purge date for temporary situations, such as fumigations. CAD will automatically purge items from the file at the purge date
